## FY 2003 Capital Region Municipal and School Finances

Local governments and school districts are required to submit annual financial reports to the N.Y.S. Comptroller's office, which is also responsible for designing the report forms and the uniform system of accounts upon which they are based. Periodic examinations of local government accounts

are conducted by municipal examiners, who not only check internal controls, State compliance, and financial reporting, but also assist localities in improving financial management procedures.

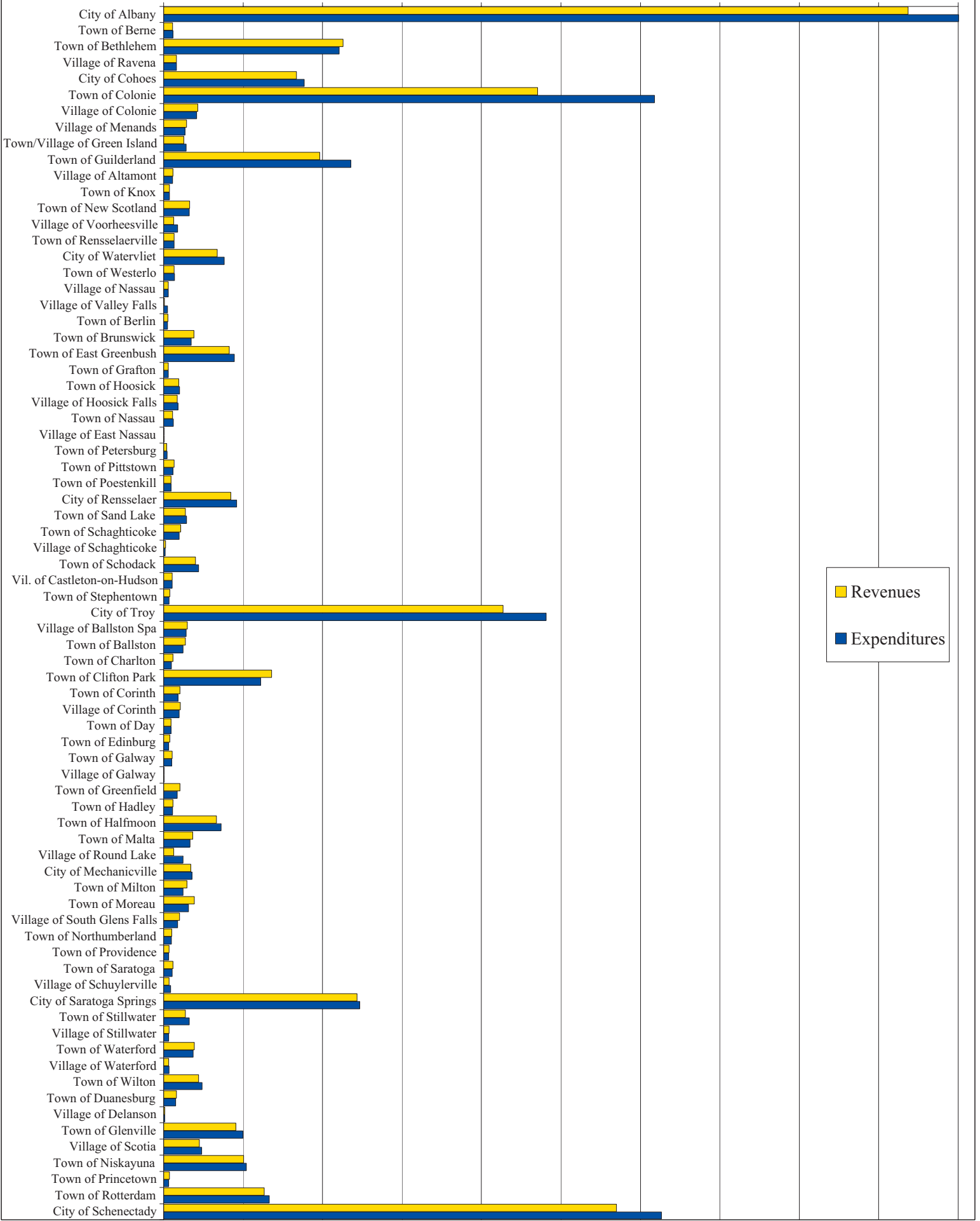

County population estimates are determined by adding demographic components of change (births - deaths + net migration) to the Census population. Sub-county estimates use housing unit estimates, based on building permits, mobile home shipments, and estimates of housing unit loss, to distribute the county population.

The estimates include all adjustments to the Census resulting from the Count Question Resolution program. In our Region, there were adjustments for the City of Albany, Town of Guilderland, Village of Voorheesville (Albany Co.), and for the towns of Clifton Park, Corinth, Halfmoon, Moreau, Saratoga, and Wilton (Saratoga Co.). The 7/1/00 estimates include the estimated population change between the Census date (4/1/00) and July 1st. Note that the estimates are based on administrative records and do not reflect actual population counts.

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file are published in the *Special Report on Municipal Affairs* that the Comptroller submits to the Legislature annually. The annual financial data and information from other sources have undergone rigorous desk review, statistical comparisons, and computer edit checks to assure validity prior to publication.

The data are presented here as a statistical overview, and are not intended to provide detailed accounting or legal information concerning the finances or financial condition of local governments. For example, the fact that a local government has expenditures in excess of revenues in a particular year does not necessarily indicate an operating deficit.

Other financing sources such as borrowings or the appropriation of fund balances are not classified as revenues and may account for the apparent shortfall.

Detailed financial information is available for any individual locality from the New York State Comptroller's Office.

This article presents selected data on revenues and expenditures from the Comptroller's latest *Report*.
