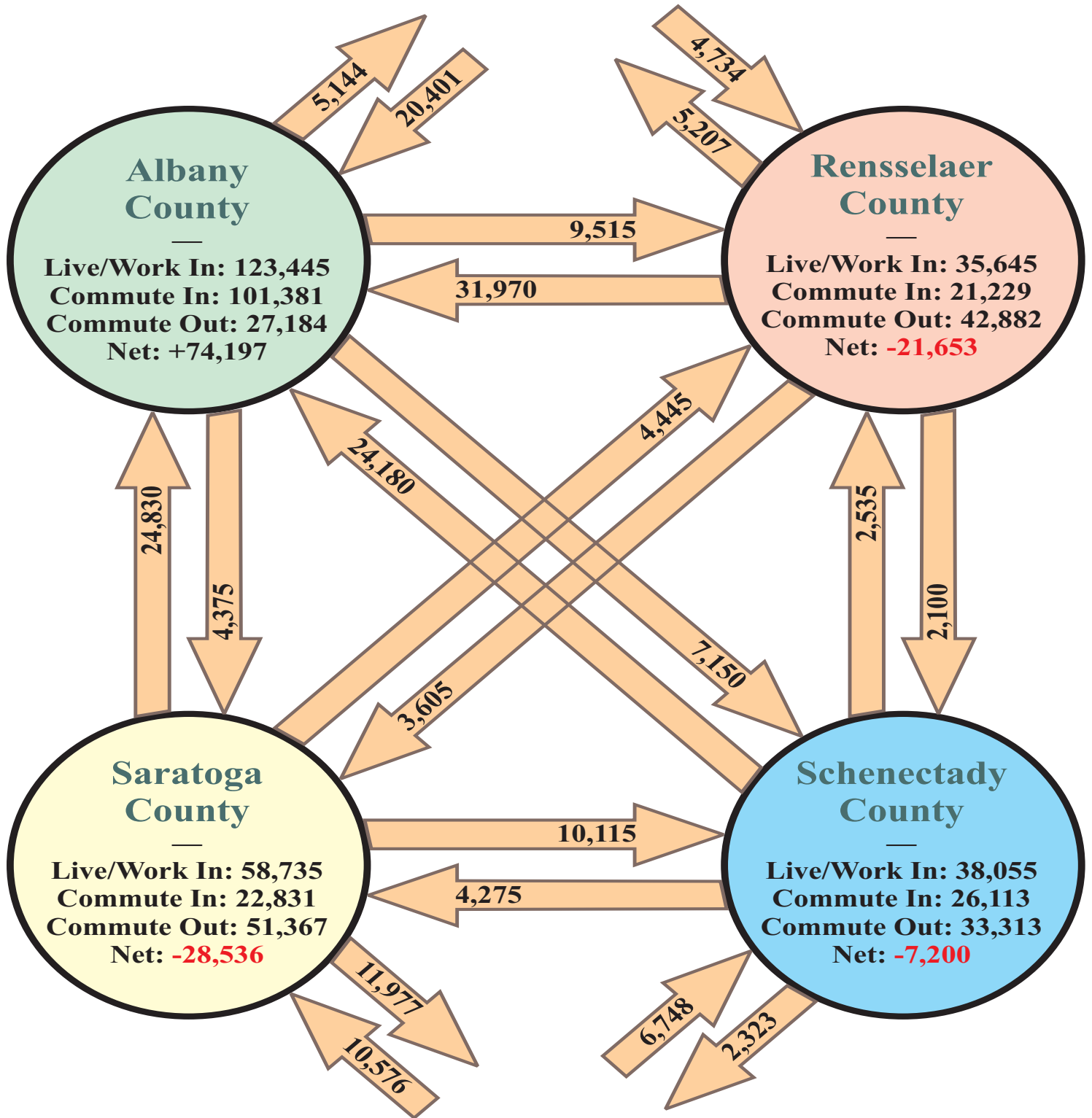

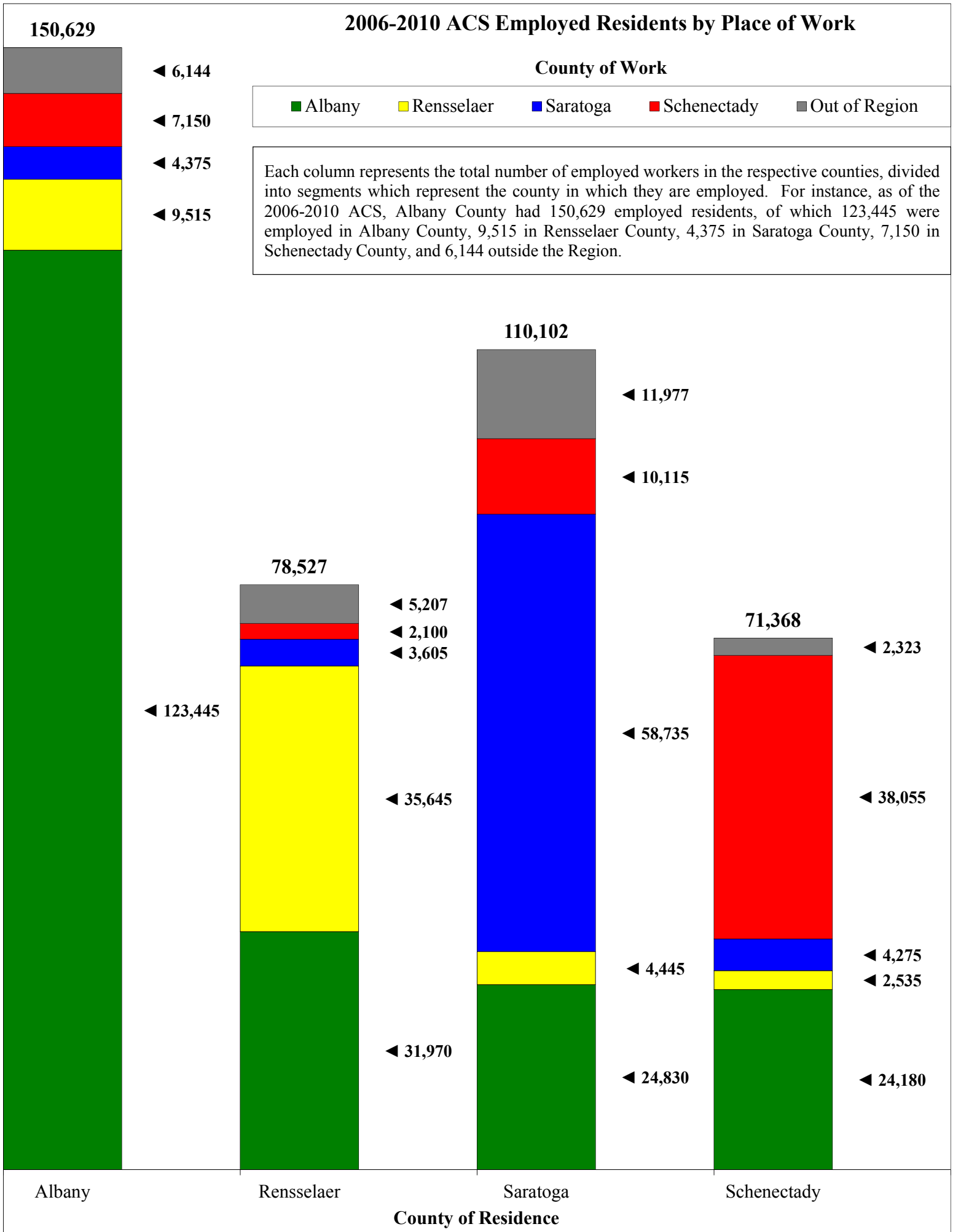

2006-2010 ACS Employed Residents by Place of Work

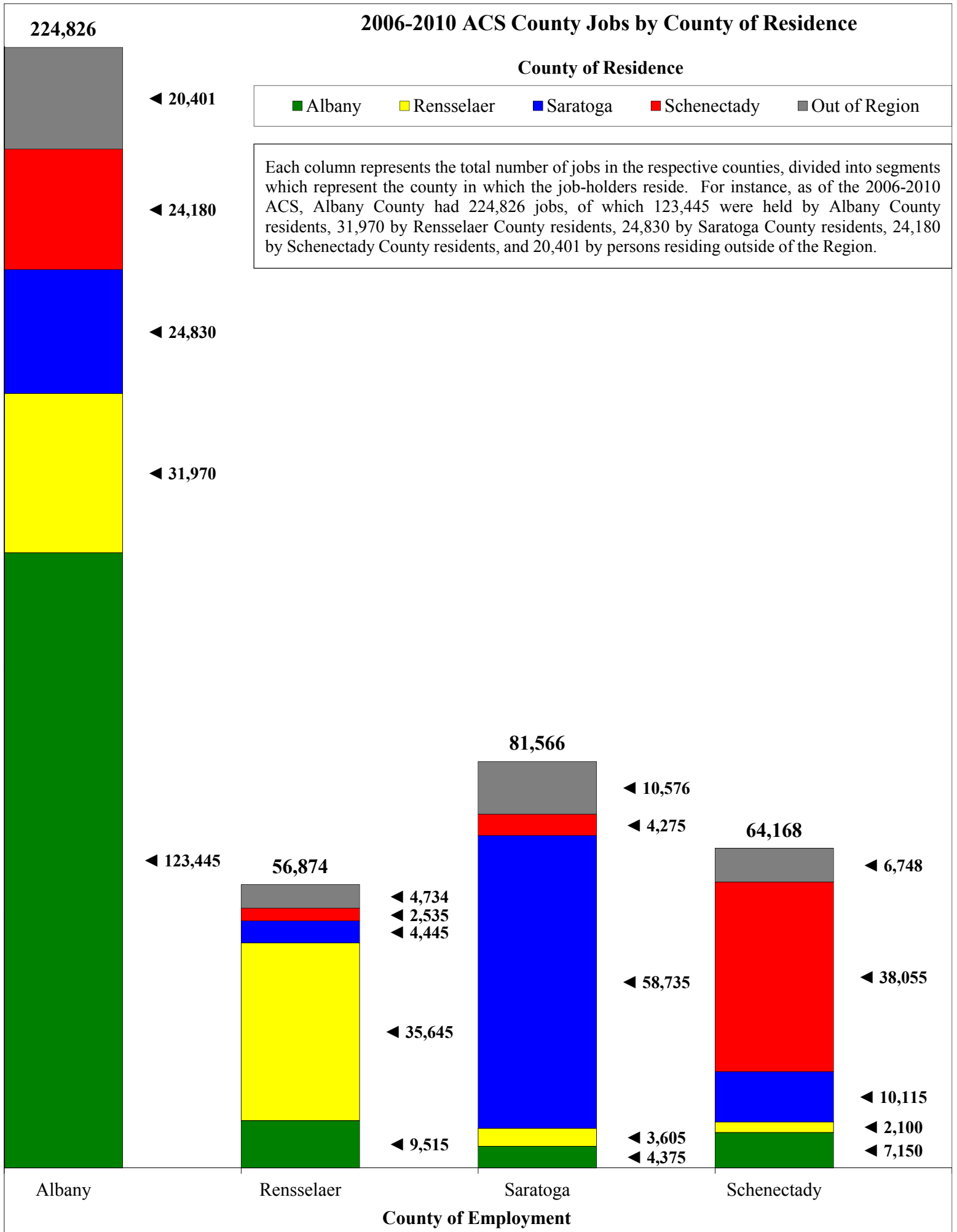


2006-2010 ACS County Jobs by County of Residence

Each column represents the total number of jobs in the respective counties, divided into segments which represent the county in which the job-holders reside. For instance, as of the 2006-2010 ACS, Albany County had 224,826 jobs, of which 123,445 were held by Albany County residents, 31,970 by Rensselaer County residents, 24,830 by Saratoga County residents, 24,180 by Schenectady County residents, and 20,401 by persons residing outside of the Region.
