2005-2009 NAICS Sector Employment Data

The New York State Department of Labor has recently released the 2009 NAICS-based employment data for N.Y.S. counties.

The tables on the following three pages present the 2005-2009 major sector data for average annual employment and pay, and the number of reporting units for each of the Region's four counties, the Capital Region, and New York State.

The table on page five contains the 2006-2009 Location Quotients and Basic Industry Employment for the same areas. Location Quotients are based on an analytical technique which compares a local economy to a reference economy (typically the U.S.) to identify specializations, if any, in the local economy. The location quotient technique is based upon a calculated

ratio between the local economy and the reference unit economy.

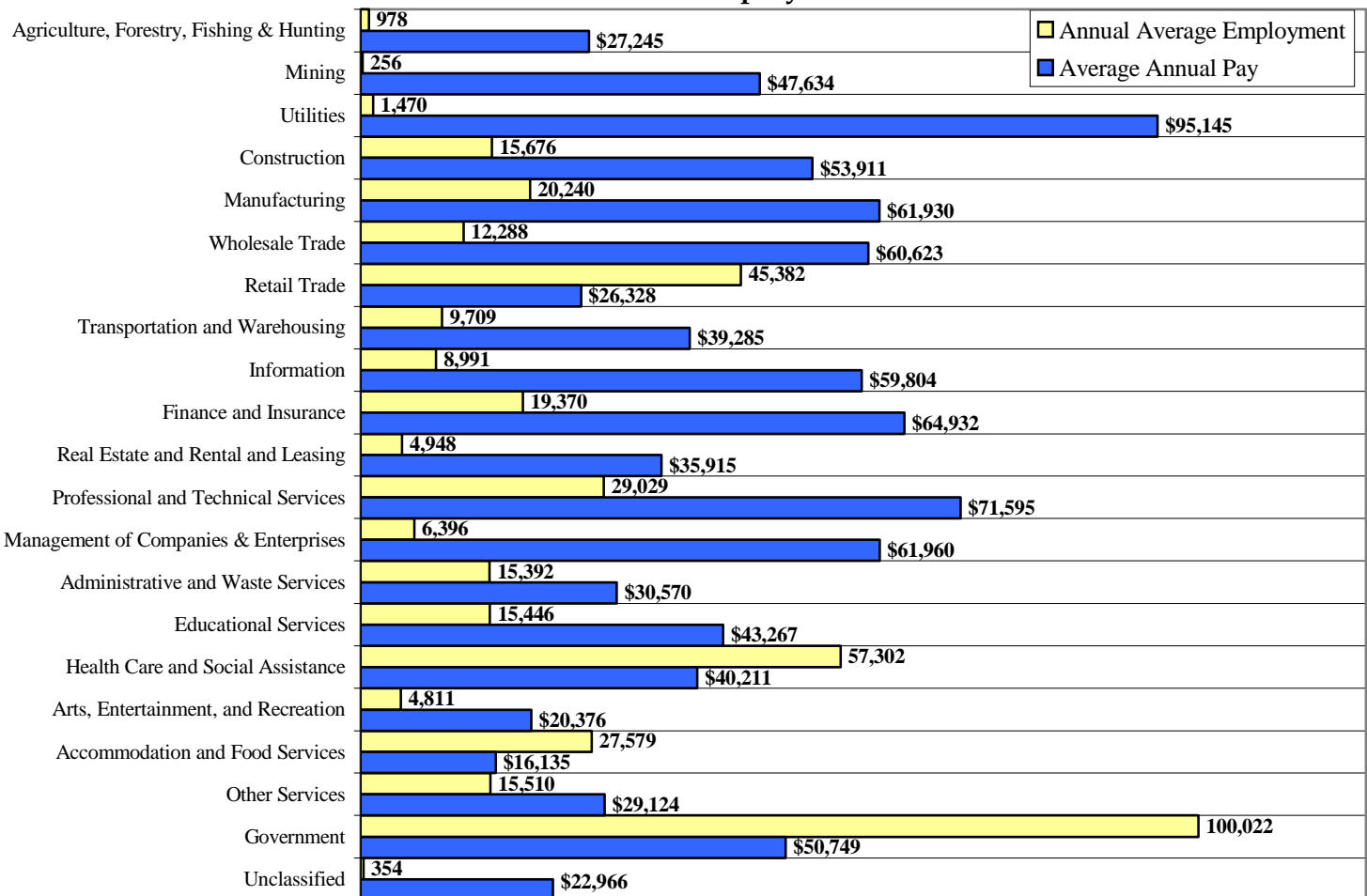
LQ = Location Quotient.
 RE_i = Sector i Local employment.
 RE_t = Total Local employment.
 NE_i = Sector i U.S. employment.
 NE_t = Total U.S. employment.

An LQ less than one (< 1) for an industry suggests that industry isn't meeting local demand for its goods or services.

An LQ of one ($= 1$) for an industry suggests that industry's output is sufficient to meet local demand for its goods or services but provides no net exports to other areas.

An LQ greater than one (> 1) for an industry suggests that industry both satisfies local demand and exports goods or services to other areas.

The employees engaged in producing goods or services for export to other areas above and beyond that required for local consumption are termed "Basic Industry Employment."

The Basic Industry figures clearly show that the Capital Region has a significant number of employees providing export goods or services. For 2009, approximately 53,420, or 13% of the Region's jobs, represented Basic Industry employment. This contrasts favorably with New York, where just 9.5% of employees produced goods or services

for export.

Some caveats on the use of LQ analysis:

- Since on a net basis the U.S. consumes far more goods than it produces, manufacturing LQs may under-state the number of industries which export in a region.
- The U.S. produces far more of some services than it consumes (e.g., entertainment), so certain service sector LQs may under-state their actual exports.
- No region will consume the same proportion of goods and/or services that are represented by the proportion of U.S. employees involved in producing them, so all LQs are rather rough estimates.
