

### What is the TIP?

- Region’s five-year capital program
- Multiple fund sources w/ different rules
- Annual total investment = \$95M - \$200M
- Federal-aid eligible facilities – State+Local
- Focused on infrastructure repair & renewal
- Projects not offered or selected by Staff – or CDTC’s Facebook Friends! 😊
- Projects submitted by municipalities & operating agencies

### What is the TIP?

- Staff evaluation and discussion with Planning Committee and project sponsors
- Planning Committee recommendation to Policy Board for adoption
- Very competitive process
- Projects derived from local and regional plans have the best chance of success
- Matched program – 20% non-federal
- Reimbursable program – project costs advanced by sponsors



- How Can a Community Submit a Candidate Project for TIP Consideration?**
- Respond to CDTC/NYS DOT solicitation – letters to all 77 municipalities
  - Attend CDTC/NYS DOT workshops
  - Develop project scope/confirm eligibility
  - Questions? Touch base with CDTC staff
  - Submit application per published instructions
  - Letter of financial commitment

- CDTC or NYSDOT staff review for completeness & eligibility
- Project evaluation using CDTC or NYSDOT procedures
- Discussion with Planning Committee and project sponsors
- Project selection – “best” w/ geographic, jurisdictional, type balance

- Major TIP Programs & Solicitation Schedule**
- **General TIP Update** – pavement, bridge, bike/ped, transit – Fall/Winter 2017
  - **FTA Section 5310** – transportation services for seniors & individuals with disabilities – Spring 2017
  - **TAP** (transportation alternatives) – bike/ped, trails, safe-routes-to-school) – August 2017
  - **HSIP** (safety) – strict eligibility criteria – Summer 2017
