Day 4: Saratoga Springs

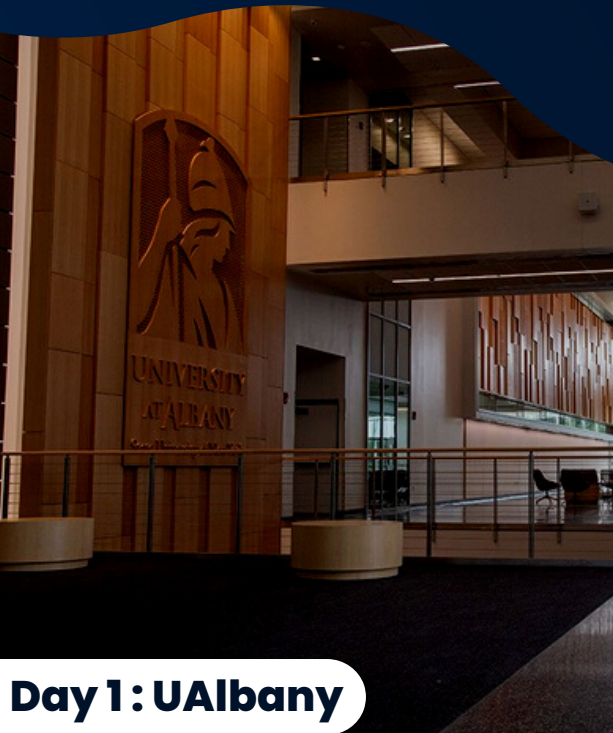
● Transportation and Ag
