


New Visions 2050

Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)
 (a/k/a regional transportation plan)

- Guides cost effective use of federal funds to meet transportation needs
- Directly relates to capital & planning project evaluation criteria

Influences the staff work priorities





- Plan development began in 2023; due Sept 2025
- Phases 1 and 2 complete
 - www.inmotionplan.com for products
- Completed 2 public surveys; ongoing public involvement
- Draft Goals, Objectives and a Vision Statement approved through September 2024
- Active transportation one of several central themes

 - Call for projects out now; proposals due Dec. 6
- ADA Transition Plans

Planning Programs

Linkage Program (up to \$150K)

- Zoning code and land use regulations
- Neighborhood and sub area plans
- Complete streets plans
- Corridor studies
- Trail feasibility studies
- Mobility hub planning
- Active transportation plans

Technical Assistance (less than \$10K)

- Data collection
- Crash data analysis
- Community visioning
- Surveys
- Training
- Site plan review assistance
- Zoning ordinance audits
- Intersection analysis

Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

- 5-year capital plan for federal transportation funds
 - Due June 2025
- Must reflect recommendations, goals, and priorities in New Visions 2050
- Solicitation open proposals due December 6, 2024





- FY22 Safe Streets and Roads for All Action Plan Grant Award - \$1.15 M
